'We think of everything' my therapist Michelle tells me as she places hot slippers on my feet after my Dr Barbara Sturm facial in the **Castle Spa** in Dromoland Castle Hotel which reopened during the summer of 2023 after a major renovation.

The spa team has cleverly thought of everything to make your experience as luxurious as possible. In the lockers where you can

handily charge your phone, you change into silk flowery robes before retreating into the spa which is designed in beautiful hues of pink. The colours are based on a rose in the garden grown 130 years ago and named after Lady Ethel, a former Lady of the castle.

The waiting room's soft pink velvet couches are plush, and hot towels are proffered along with cucumber water and a sorbet, while there are reading glasses discretely placed on the table for those of us who may need a little assistance while filling out the spa form.

There are six treatment rooms in the 320sqft sanctuary including an Amber and Quartz Crystal bed should you wish to have a hot massage or facial. Each room has a plaque outside it with different greenery from the estate, these are changed seasonally.

The spa offers three different wellness brands which are all exclusive in Ireland to Dromoland Castle. I am here to try the Dr Barbara Sturm facial. Sturm is a German doctor who has a massive cult following in the US and was selected for the huge amount of Americans who visit the spa. Her skin-healing philosophy delivers non-surgical, anti-aging and anti-inflammation treatments that rejuvenate stressed skin.

Before my treatment, Michelle explained the uplifting and sculpting techniques of the facial while I got under a duvet onto the bed complete with a pillow, and as the light was dimmed stars twinkled in the ceiling above.


A cold towel was placed on my face to open my pores before my skin was exfoliated and Hyaluronic ampoules were poured onto the skin with light brush strokes and my face massaged.

The Whisper Room is where you go to relax afterward. Each of the six beds is adjustable and massage you as you snooze, there are curtains to pull around you should you wish for privacy.

Raspberry iced tea was quietly placed beside me along with petit fours and strawberries on a beautiful floral plate. Should you wish to read, each bed has a book of Fairy tales beside it along with adult colouring books, they have thought of everything here.
